

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



A BRIEF HISTORY:

Located in the western fringe of the fast-expanding Guwahati city, Paschim Guwahati Mahavidyalaya was established on 5th September, 1978. In its 44 years of existence till date, the college has been continuously scaling new heights, crossing notable milestones in its academic and co-curricular activities. Situated beside the Deepar Beel, the college has a lush green environment which is a sight to behold. Thanks to the foresight and immense social commitment of founder-Principal Late Bipin Chandra Baruah along with a group of like-minded individuals, this institute of higher learning was set up with the noble mission of developing precious human resource. Form a humble beginning with a single Assam-type house, the college has grown into a multi-storeyed complex, along with fisheries and a grove of medicinal plants. This growth of physical infrastructure has come as a natural corollary to the primary focus of the college in building up a social capital, by training its students to excel in academic pursuits and other diverse fields. Many of them have brought laurels to the college by succeeding in the State and National level events.

Paschim Guwahati Mahavidyalaya today is a full-fledged degree college imparting Higher Education in Arts and Commerce, along with a plethora of courses under IDOL (Institute of Distance and Open Learning of Gauhati University), KKHSOU (Krishna Kanta Handique State Open University), Beautification course etc. The Arts stream of the college had been brought under the deficit-grant-in-aid system by the Assam Government in the year 1996 and provincialised in the year 2005. Teaching posts of the commerce stream have been provincialised as per the Assam Venture Educational Institution (Provincialisation of Service) Act, 2011 and amended in 2012 with respect to degree colleges of Assam. Paschim Guwahati Mahavidyalaya has been accredited by NAAC in 2004, 2015 and 2022 and it had been registered under 2 (F) and 12 (B) of the UGC Act, 1956 in February, 2005. The College is permanently affiliated to Gauhati University. For the first time in its history the college could achieve another milestone in the teaching-learning process by introducing post-graduate course in Political Science and Assamese from 2020-21 session and BCA from 2022-23 session under Gauhati University. The College also regularly serves as a venue for different examinations on Sundays. This year Paschim Guwahati Mahavidyalaya has been reaccredited by NAAC and the College has been able to achieve B+ grade from C⁺⁺ and B Grades in the years 2004 and 2015.



AIMS AND OBJECTIVES:

- 1. To ensure accessibility to higher education for local youths as well as Northeast region of India.
- 2. To develop awareness among the youths regarding the current social, political, economic and environmental problems
- 3. To educate, upgrade and instill a sense of culture among youths, helping them to adopt and adapt to the changing trends of the present

- 6. To build up awareness among youths of the rich heritage of India with its art, culture and tradition and strive for its preservation

THE COLLEGE CAMPUS:

The college campus extends over 15 bighas of land, bordered by primary school and higher seconday school on one side. The lush green environment of open fields on the other sides, creates a healthy environment proper for an institution of higher learning.

The campus includes an Assam type block along with a three-storeyed RCC building connecting two blocks at a right angle housing the Principal's office, Teachers' common rooms of Arts and Commerce departments, Committee room, classrooms, library, laboratories, students' common room and two well equipped conference rooms and an indoor sports complex. There is also a two storied Women's hostel in the college campus and the total seat capacity has been increased to 70.

The canteen is in a separate Assam type house within the college campus. Well-maintained gardens along with shade-giving trees create a suitable ambience. The two fisheries of the college covering areas of 1.5 bigha, and 4 Kathas, enhance the scenic beauty of the campus. Newly constructed Conference Hall at 1st floor on


Bipin Chandra Baruah library has been completed. Sufficient space has been kept aside for parking vehicles.

CLASSROOMS

At any time, the college can simultaneously hold several classes from Higher Secondary first year to post Graduate Classes.

LABORATORIES

The Laboratories are associated with the Department of Education in Arts Faculty and Computer Education (Arts & Commerce). The college also possess a language laboratory which had been constructed with RUSA funds housed near the English Department.

DIGITAL LIBRARY

The Digital library is named after the Founder Principal of the college, Late Bipin



Chandra Baruah. Over the years, there has been a substantial increase in the number of books in the library, numbering more than 40,000 at present. It is well stocked with texts and reference books, along with classics, several lexicons and encyclopedia series, as well as books of general interest covering a wide range of topics in English, Assamese, Bengali and Hindi. Book Bank facility is offered to the meritorious and poor students. The library also subscribes to journals and 9 newspapers, with an eye to keep the students up-to-date with current affairs. Computers have been installed with LAN/OPAC and SOUL 2.0 software. There is separate reading space for students and teachers with 9 nos. of computers facilitating internet access in the E-resource centre.

LIBRARY BY-LAWS

- 1. No book is issued without library card and books are not transferable.
- 2. Two library cards are issued to each student for an academic session. An additional card is given to students having honours subject.
- 3. One book is issued against each card.
- 4. If the book is not returned within the stipulated time limit, a fine of Rs. 3/- is imposed per day per book upto 15 days and thereafter it is increased to Rs. 5/- per day.
- 5. Books may be retained for a period not exceeding 15 days by members.
- 6. Books may be renewed on request at the discretion of the Librarian.
- 7. Misuse of library book is a serious offence. Unless the borrower points out the damage at the time of borrowing the book, he/she shall be required to replace the book or pay its price.
- Dog-earing the pages of a book, marking or writing therein with ink or pencil, tearing or taking out its pages, or otherwise damaging it and causing injury to the book will bring penalty.

DIGITAL COMPUTER ROOM:

The College has one well-equiped Digital Computer Room for Academic purpose.

TEACHERS' COMMON ROOMS

There are separate rooms for academic departments with attached washrooms and Kitchenettes All departments have departmental libraries which issue books to 'Students of Honours'. All departments maintain wall magazines and some publish departmental magazines as well.



Departments also conduct seminars where teachers and students take active part.

COMMON ROOMS FOR STUDENTS

There are separate common rooms for boys and girls with adequate facilities for recreation and entertainment.

GAMES AND SPORTS

The College encourages students to take part in games and sports at various levels and gives financial support whenever found necessary. It has got a well-equipped indoor sports facilities and a well equipped Gymnasium.

CONFERENCE ROOM

The college has two well-equipped Conference Rooms.

IQAC ROOM

The IQAC Room houses four committees of the college with separate sitting arrangements-(IQAC, RUSA, Extension Education, UGC Planning Board) with almirahs, Computers and Wifi facilities.

WOMENS' HOSTEL

The College has a newly built Womens' Hostel with a capacity for 70 students.

ART AND CULTURE

To make the students aware of the rich Indian art, culture and traditions, the college has been organizing vocational training programmes time to time such as weaving, doll making, painting, music and preparing traditional delicacies. These courses have enabled the students to make them all partially independent.

Regulation of TDC CBCS Course for Semester System of G.U.

- 1. General Considerations:
- i) Under Graduate (UG) Courses

Pass mark: 30% for individual theory paper and 40% for individual practical paper.

Simple pass: 30% marks in aggregate, i.e. minimum CGPA of 4.00.

Major in UG: 40% marks in aggregate in major subjects, i.e. minimum CGPA of 5.00.

First class for UG Major: 60% marks in aggregate. i.e. minimum CGPA of 7.00.

The subjects which do not possess practical papers, their total tutorial classes should be such that they equal the total practical plus tutorial classes of subjects having practical in all the undergraduate (UG) course. These should be balanced.

2. TDC shall be of Six Semesters covering three Calendar Years. The Schedule for semester system shall be as shown below:



- (a) Odd Semester [First, Third and Fifth Semesters].
- (b) **Even Semesters** [Second, Fourth and Sixth Semesters].
- (c) **Semester break :** [Subject to GU / Govt. notification]
- 3. Student's performance should be monitored throughout the Semester by continuous assessment in the theory and practical course. Evaluation of the Students performance in each of the theory and practical paper will be based on the following:

Internal Evaluation : 20% marks (Subjectwise as per CBCS regulation) External Evaluation : 80% marks

- 4. 75% class attendance is mandatory.
- 5. Internal Evaluation should be based on attendance performance, sessional examination, home assignments, seminars, and library work in each Semester.
- 6. External Evaluation should be through a final examination at the end of the semester.
- 7. The pass marks in each theory paper is 30% and that in each partical paper is 40%. (as per CBCS regulation for CBCS course)
- 8. In each paper, students must secure pass marks in both the internal as well as the external evaluation separately.
- 9. A student who could not appear or failed in any semester examination will be allowed to clear the same as follows:
 - a) First Semester.
 b) Second Semester. (As per CBCS regulation and GU/Govt. notification)
 c) Third Semester.
 - d) Fourth Semester with regular Sixth Semester examination.
 - e) Fifth Semester with regular Fifth Semester examination of the next batch.
 - f) Sixth Semester with regular Sixth Semester examination of the next batch.



- 10. A student may be allowed to 'repeat any one of the theory papers in each of the First, Second, Third, Fourth, Fifth and Sixth semester for "betterment" of marks in one paper in each Semester provided the student secure less than 505 marks or grade point 5.0 in that paper in TDC.
- 11. No "repeat" / "betterment" shall be allowed in the practical examinations in any Semester.
- 12. A student must pass all his semester examinations, including "repeat" and "betterment" chances within five years from the date of admission to the first Semester course in TDC. A student will get a maximum of three chances to clear a particular Semester.
- 13. Since the Semester involve continuous assessment there would be no scope for a student to appear as a private candidate in any subject / course.

B.Com. (Hons.) Three-Year (6th Semester) CBCS Programme:

Applicants to the B.Com. course must have completed 10+2 for the Commerce stream with minimum 35% marks.

B.A. COURSE THREE YEAR CBCS PROGRAMME

Under the CBCS Programme designed by the UGC the students can access the liberty to choose from a wide range of courses and learn at their own pace. The entire assessment is graded on a credit system. The idea is to keep up-to-date with the development of higher education in India and abroad. The students may undertake as many credits as they can cope with (not repeating the courses if they fail in one/more courses). CBCS allows the students to choose inter- disciplinary, intra-disciplinary, skill oriented papers according to their needs, interests and aptitude. The UGC has recommended that its is desirable for all institutions of higher education in the country to move to CBCS and together with it implement a uniform grading system.

Nature and Nomenclature of Courses under CBCS, GU

As per the UGC's guidelines, the couses are categorized as Core course, Elective course or Ability Enhancement Courses:

4.1 Core Course : A Core course is a course that has to be compulsorily studied. A student in an undergraduate degree programme with Honours will have to take up 14 core courses, each of 6 credits. In a regular undergraduate degree programme a student will have to take up 12 core courses, each again of 6



credits.

- 4.2 Elective Course : An Elective course is to be chosen by the student from a pool of such courses on offer and will essentially be of three types :
- 4.2.1 Discipline Speific Elective Course : An Elective Course which is offered by the main discipline. The discipline offering a Discipline Specific Elective course may also offer discipline related elective course that are inter-disciplinary in nature.
- 4.2.2 Generic Elective Course : A Generic Elective Course is offered by an unrelated discipline and has the objective of broadening the academic experience of a student.
- 4.2.3 Dissertation/Project : Engaging students in a Project/Dissertation work, which requires knowledge application and problem solving is considered to be important in the learning process.
- 4.3 Ability Enhancement Courses: Ability Enhancement Courses which are to be taken up by students in an undergraduate degree program will be of two types.
- 4.3.1 Ability Enhancement Compulsory Course
- 4.3.2 Skill Enhancement Courses

ৰেগিং এক দণ্ডণীয় অপৰাধ ঃ Important Note on Prohibition of Ragging & Harassment

As per UGC Guideline [no. F1-16/2007 (CPP-II), April, 2009], all forms of ragging in hostels and the college campus are prohibited, Ragging is considered as a cognizable offence under the law of the land and ragging in all its forms is totally banned in the entire institution, including its departments, constituent units, all its premises (academic, residential, sports, canteen etc.) whether located within the campus or outside and in all means of transportation of students whether public or private. Punishable ingredients of Ragging are (1) Abetment of Ragging; (2) Criminal conspiracy to rag; (3) Unlawful assembly and rioting while ragging; (4) Public nuisance created during ragging; (5) Violation of decency and morals through ragging; (6) Injury to body, causing hurt or grievous hurt; (7) Wrongful restraint; (8) Wrongful confinement; (9) Use of criminal force; (10) Assault as well as sexual offences or unnatural offences; (11) Extortion; (12) Criminal trespass; (13) Offences against property; (14) Criminal intimidation; (15) Attempts to commit any or all of the above mentioned offences against the victim; (16) Physical or psychological humiliation; (17) All other offences following from the definition of "Ragging".

Following strong disciplinary action may be taken if any one is found to be involved directly or indirectly in ragging:

- → Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
- → Withholding, withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits.
- + Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process.
- → Withholding results.
- + Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, touranament, youth festival etc.
- Suspension/Expulsion from the hostel.
- + Cancellation of admission.



- + Rustication from the institution for period ranging from 1 to 2 years.
- + Expulsion for the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for specified period.
- + Fine ranging between Rs. 25,000/- and Rs.1,00,000/-
- + Collective punishment : when the persons committing or abetting the crime or ranging are not identified, the authority will resort to collective punishment.




