GUIDELINES FOR HANDLING, PLANTING & PROTECTING SEEDLINGS



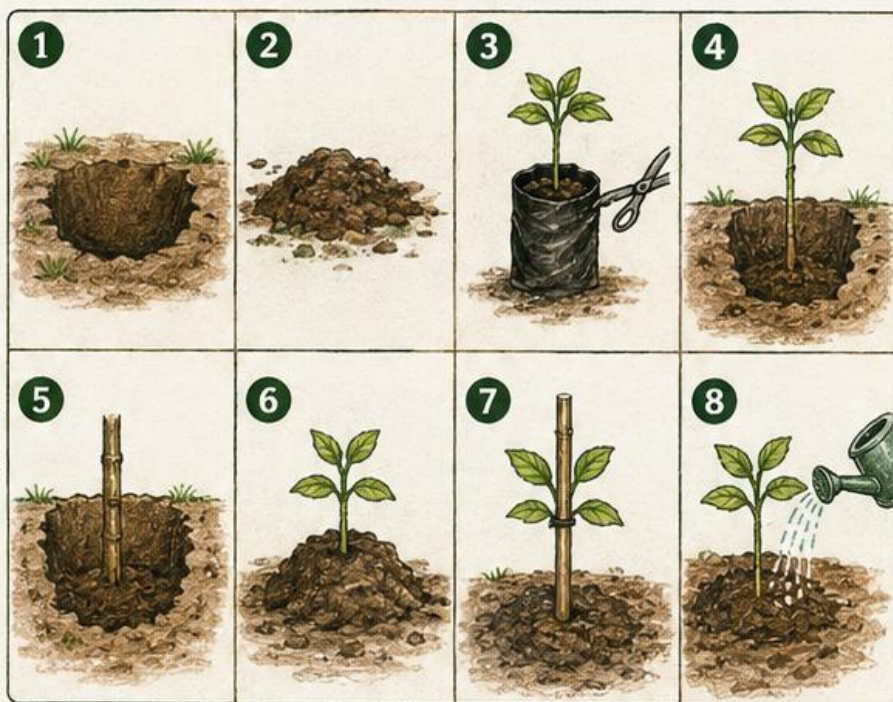
1. BEFORE PLANTING

- Handle seedlings gently. Do not damage the polybag or root system.
- Water the seedlings lightly once a day.
- Do not water two days before transportation.
- Keep seedlings in the shade and avoid direct sunlight.
- Do not water one day before planting.



2. PLANTING PROCEDURE

- Dig a pit (1ft x 1ft x 1ft) at least 1 day before planting and mix the soil with organic manure.
- Remove the soil from the pit one day before planting.
- Carefully cut and remove the polybag without disturbing the soil.
- Place the seedling in the center of the pit.
- Fill the pit with soil mix, keeping the root collar level with the ground.
- Firm the soil gently around the plant.
- Provide support with a bamboo stick and tie it loosely with jute string.
- Water the seedling gently after planting.



3. PROTECTION



Provide a tree guard using 3 or 4 stakes / sticks in a triangle or square shape.



Wrap the sides with agro-net, jute fabric or any suitable material to prevent damage.



Protect seedlings from grazing, fire, and other damages until they are well established.



NOTE

Regular care and protection in the early stage ensures healthy growth and a better tomorrow.
